WHAT TO REPORT:

- Credit card fraud
- Identity theft
- Lost property
- Telephone harassment
- Vandalism (under \$750)
- Vehicle damage (no suspect)
- Theft

DID YOU KNOW?

Filing a false police report is a crime and may result in prosecution.

BEFORE FILING ENSURE:

- The incident is NOT an emergency.
- The incident happened within Port St. Lucie City limits.
- It did NOT occur on 1-95 or the Florida Turnpike.
- You're 18+ years old and have a valid email address.
- There are no known suspects.

INFORMATION YOU NEED:

- Date, time and location of the incident.
- Names and contact info of those involved.
- Details about the property (if applicable).

WHAT TO EXPECT:

You'll receive a temporary report number with an option to print a copy. The report will be reviewed and follow-up may occur if needed.
